



**Brought to you by Nevada Community Prevention Coalition Inc.**

Your child has been asked to participate in the Peer Assistance Leadership (PAL) program, which is being implemented by Nevada Community Prevention Coalition Inc. PAL is a program designed to increase the engagement of students and youth. The program works by identifying *unengaged youth* and providing to them *leadership training* and *adult mentorship* from active community members. A certified PAL trainer will provide one-day training sessions for to youth and adults. NvCPC will provide continued program support and oversight once both parties have received the training.

***The level of commitment required by parents or guardians of youth is as follows:***

1. Parents or guardians are asked to provide transportation for their child to and from a one-day PAL program training session. Training dates have not yet been determined, but training will most likely take place in the beginning of July. Training locations will be available in northern and southern Clark County.
2. Parents or guardians must grant permission for their child to participate in future activities with adult mentors, including participation in community events and youth advisory boards, as well as interacting through social media or other forms of communication. Physical interactions with adult mentors will be limited to group settings in public locations. All adult mentors will be subjected to background checks prior to program participation.
3. Parents or guardians are asked to help Nevada Community Prevention Coalition Inc. identify specific behaviors they would like to see improved

upon within their child and assist staff by providing baseline and future data related to these behaviors. Our staff will ask you questions related to the frequency of behaviors and their improvement over time. Staff members will also view your child’s school report cards or progress reports.

4. Parents are strongly encouraged to attend community events or parent workshops presented by the PAL program or Nevada Community Prevention Coalition Inc., however attendance is not mandatory.

In order for your child to participate in Nevada Community Prevention Coalition Inc.’s PAL program, you must agree to the outlined commitments listed above by completing the form below.
